Choosing Tracks

Classic Track

Our basic program: 2 skills per day (both chosen 1st day), swimming, zip line, other activities, Discovery, meals, chapel and a wide game. It gives all the options, without giving focus to a particular area or skill.

Note: Classic and PA campers can share cabins, as can WT with OC.

Outdoor Challenge Track

Focuses on outdoor living, archery, riflery, wall climbing and a challenging overnight hike. The schedule includes meals, Discovery, chapels, wide games and some opportunity for choice in other areas. Campers with experience in this track may also wish to try a SWAT trip. (OC not pre-requisite)

Waterfront Track

This track focuses on canoeing, kayaking, sailing, knee-boarding and a challenging overnight canoe trip. The schedule includes meals, Discovery, chapels, wide games and some opportunity for choice in other areas.

Performing Arts Track

An increased focus on drama, theatre, music, puppetry and similar skills. Performances are encouraged, but not mandatory. The schedule also includes meals, Discovery, chapels, wide games and opportunity for choice in other areas.
