The present practice is each request is filtered through the Superintendent or designate. Requests such as the Gideon Bible distribution are brought to the Board for approval on an ad hoc basis.

This policy would have no communication from outside the schools go through the school. This includes Brochures from Camp Sagitawa, the Gideon bible distribution (with parental consent) to grade fives. The exception would be City Parks & Recreation programs, NLC and other educational institutions.

I am a trustee from area E and am opposed to this policy. I believe that Camp Sagitawa does indeed support provincial curriculum and school goals within its structure. It would be a detriment to kids if indeed your brochures were to be banned.

I am hoping this policy will be talked about by the community and that individuals would write their local trustee (or myself) or they can send letters to the Superintendent (Kathy Sawchuk) and voice their opinion.

This policy is out for a 45 school day consult. It will come to the September Board meeting for final approval. If no comments are received it will go forward.
